


ASEC is a **trade-focused security hardware brand** built around the “everyday kit” locksmiths and installers reach for, with a big emphasis on **breadth, availability, and value** rather than boutique-only spec pieces. - Coverage is intentionally broad across the core trade categories: **Access Control, Architectural Hardware, Key Cutting, Locking Products, UPVC, Tools & Accessories.**

ASEC is **exclusive to Aldridge Security** (whom we distribute) in the UK trade ecosystem (Aldridge explicitly calls itself the **exclusive distributor of ASEC Security Products worldwide**). That exclusivity is a big part of the brand's identity: it keeps the range aimed at the trade channel rather than getting diluted into mass retail.
