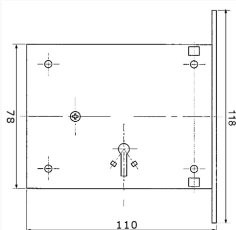

## Product Description

The Asec FB1 2 Lever Mortice Deadlock is a specialised fire brigade lock designed specifically for use by the London Fire Service and other authorised personnel. It is commonly installed on communal doors, dry riser cupboards, bin stores, and plant rooms to ensure emergency services can gain immediate access to restricted areas in the event of an emergency.

This robust mortice deadlock features a warded 2-lever mechanism and is keyed alike to the standard FB1 key profile. This means any standard FB1 mortice key can operate the lock, facilitating seamless access for fire crews and maintenance teams. Please note that keys are not included with this lock and must be purchased separately.

With a 52mm backset and a 110mm case depth, this lock is designed for straightforward installation into standard timber doors. It provides a reliable, standardised security solution that balances restricted public access with essential emergency service entry.

ASEC is **exclusive to Aldridge Security** (whom we distribute) in the UK trade ecosystem (Aldridge explicitly calls itself the **exclusive distributor of ASEC Security Products worldwide**). That exclusivity is a big part of the brand's identity: it keeps the range aimed at the trade channel rather than getting diluted into mass retail.
