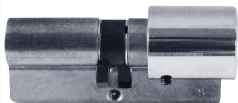

The Banham S464 Euro Double Cylinder (also known as the BPL1000) is a high-security double cylinder designed for use with Banham security locks, including older Banham S464 mortice locks. This double cylinder is operated with a key from both sides and features a robust security cowl on the external side to protect against tampering and physical attack.

It features a split cam design and utilizes a high-security Banham 12-pin mechanism. To ensure maximum key control and security, duplicate keys must be obtained directly from Banham patent locks.

Banham



Banham is a **London-based, family-run security company** best known for its **high-security locks**, locksmithing, and wider home-and-business security services across **London and the South East**. The business traces its roots to **1926**, when **William F. Banham** developed an early **automatic door bolt** after repeated burglaries at his wife’s West London dressmaking shop, launching what became Banham Patent Locks.

Over nearly a century, Banham has grown from lockmaking into a full security provider, combining **physical security** (locks and door hardware) with **electronic security** such as **alarms, CCTV, and access control**, plus services like **keyholding** and **24/7 alarm response**.

In the trade/public eye, Banham is especially associated with:

- **Banham-branded locks** (marketed as UK-crafted, with an emphasis on distinctive design and robust burglary resistance).
- **24/7 emergency locksmith coverage** for lockouts, lock changes, and repairs, positioned as vetted, insured, and professional (and very much “don’t get scammed by a rogue locksmith” coded).
- A “heritage + service footprint” story: **four generations, since 1926**, and a long-standing focus on London’s residential and commercial market.
