Product Description

The BL2701MG series falls under our Marine Grade category of locks. With a specialized e-plating process and fully stainless steel internal parts, the lock has undergone salt spray testing to over 1000 hours. The BL2701MG comes with a key override, as well a marine grade variant of our 60mm tubular latch.

The BL2700MG series is part of the Marine Grade series of mechanical locks. Undergoing a specialist e-plating process that has been salt spray tested to over 1000 hours and having all critical internals made of the highest standard of stainless steel, the unit is designed for continued usage in the harshest conditions. This offers a solution where compliance to the ISPS code is essential and it's neither convinient or feasible to use a electronic or key driven access control solution.

With it being cycle tested to 100,000 cycles to show it's durability, the BL2701 represents the medium tier of small, mechanical keypad locks. This keypad comes with over 8000 potential combinations and a key override, allowing the key to bypass the code.

This lock comes with a anti-thrust 60mm tubular latch that is fully marine grade and made of durable materials.

As an added extra, this unit can come with a holdback function as required at no additional cost for situations where the door needs to remain open and unlocked.

This lock is suitable for external use on timber and composite doors and gates.

Borg (trading as **Borg Locks**) is a UK access-control brand best known for **mechanical, keyless push-button door and gate locks**: the classic “no batteries, no wiring, just a code” approach that’s popular for shared doors, staff entrances, plant rooms, gates, and anywhere keys inevitably get lost, copied, or ceremonially dropped down a drain.

Borg has been **designing, creating, and distributing mechanical access-control devices since 1997**, with a product line built around different duty levels and environments - from light internal use to heavy-duty commercial traffic.

The range is deliberately broad and application-led: Borg markets keypad locks for **timber doors, steel doors, aluminium doors, gates**, plus specialist lines like **fire-tested keypads** and **marine-grade/weather-resistant** options for exposed installations.

A big “Borg-ism” you’ll see repeatedly is **easy code management** - for example their **Easicode Pro (ECP)** range is designed for **on-the-door code changes** without removing the lock (useful for rentals, staff turnover, site access, etc.).
