The BL3400DKO comes with a marine grade, lever handled keypad one side and a lever handle keypad on the other. This particular model comes equipped with a key override and deadbolt function as standard.

Combining a specially designed lockcase with a marine grade keypad, the BL3000 gate lock series is designed for metal box section gates. The lockcase utilizes a forend fixing system to ease up any fitting issues.

The BL3400DKO comes with a free turning handle fitting on the keypad until the correct code is entered. The anti-climb lockcase comes with a fully adjustable and reversible latchbolt, allowing it to fit onto metal box sections of many thicknesses and both right hand and left hand hung gates.

This particular model however, separates itself from the conventional BL3400 with the inclusion of a key override. This allows entry with a separate key and offers a deadbolt function as standard.

As with all of our black Marine Grade models, this lock is salt spray tested to 1000 hours. This is suited for external metal box section gates between 30-60mm on standard fixings. An XL latchbolt is available to suit profiles up to 120mm as an optional extra (part S311a).

Borg (trading as **Borg Locks**) is a UK access-control brand best known for **mechanical, keyless push-button door and gate locks**: the classic “no batteries, no wiring, just a code” approach that’s popular for shared doors, staff entrances, plant rooms, gates, and anywhere keys inevitably get lost, copied, or ceremonially dropped down a drain.

Borg has been **designing, creating, and distributing mechanical access-control devices since 1997**, with a product line built around different duty levels and environments - from light internal use to heavy-duty commercial traffic.

The range is deliberately broad and application-led: Borg markets keypad locks for **timber doors, steel doors, aluminium doors, gates**, plus specialist lines like **fire-tested keypads** and **marine-grade/weather-resistant** options for exposed installations.

A big “Borg-ism” you’ll see repeatedly is **easy code management** - for example their **Easicode Pro (ECP)** range is designed for **on-the-door code changes** without removing the lock (useful for rentals, staff turnover, site access, etc.).
