The Borg Locks BL3400 is a heavy-duty, single-sided digital lock designed specifically for metal box-section gates. Combining a robust, specially engineered lockcase with Borg's proven marine-grade keypad, it provides a highly secure and reliable access control solution for both residential and commercial outdoor environments.

This model features a coded keypad with a free-turning lever handle on the outside, and a plain, uncoded lever handle on the inside. This setup is ideal for installations where secure, coded entry is required from the outside, while allowing free, unrestricted exit from the inside.

Equipped with Borg's innovative Easicode Pro (ECP) system, the BL3400 allows you to change the entry code on-the-door in seconds, completely eliminating the need to remove the lock from the gate. The lock is finished in a marine-grade satin black coating that has been salt spray tested for over 1,000 hours, ensuring exceptional resistance to harsh weather and coastal environments.

With an adjustable, reversible latchbolt and telescopic fixings, the BL3400 is straightforward to install and can be easily handed on-site to suit both left- and right-hand hung gates.

**Borg** (trading as **Borg Locks**) is a UK access-control brand best known for **mechanical, keyless push-button door and gate locks**: the classic “no batteries, no wiring, just a code” approach that’s popular for shared doors, staff entrances, plant rooms, gates, and anywhere keys inevitably get lost, copied, or ceremonially dropped down a drain.

Borg has been **designing, creating, and distributing mechanical access-control devices since 1997**, with a product line built around different duty levels and environments - from light internal use to heavy-duty commercial traffic.

The range is deliberately broad and application-led: Borg markets keypad locks for **timber doors, steel doors, aluminium doors, gates**, plus specialist lines like **fire-tested keypads** and **marine-grade/weather-resistant** options for exposed installations.

A big “Borg-ism” you’ll see repeatedly is **easy code management** - for example their **Easicode Pro (ECP)** range is designed for **on-the-door code changes** without removing the lock (useful for rentals, staff turnover, site access, etc.).
