The Borg Locks BL6001 is a heavy-duty, narrow-stile mechanical digital lock designed for doors where space is limited. Featuring an exceptionally slim 45mm body width, it is the ideal security solution for narrow-stile UPVC, aluminium, composite, and timber doors.

At the heart of the BL6001 is a unique, patented coding system. Utilizing a single column of eight buttons, the lock supports a double-button press system, allowing the same digit to be programmed twice in a single code. This provides over 2,100 potential code combinations for enhanced security.

For added convenience, the BL6001 features an optional free passage mode, allowing unrestricted access without entering a code when required. The free-turning external handle is permanently clutched, meaning it rotates freely without engaging the latch until the correct code is entered, protecting the internal mechanism against forced entry. This model is supplied with a 60mm backset tubular latch and features a 70-degree handle rotation, making it highly compatible with multi-point locks.

Borg (trading as **Borg Locks**) is a UK access-control brand best known for **mechanical, keyless push-button door and gate locks**: the classic “no batteries, no wiring, just a code” approach that’s popular for shared doors, staff entrances, plant rooms, gates, and anywhere keys inevitably get lost, copied, or ceremonially dropped down a drain.

Borg has been **designing, creating, and distributing mechanical access-control devices since 1997**, with a product line built around different duty levels and environments - from light internal use to heavy-duty commercial traffic.

The range is deliberately broad and application-led: Borg markets keypad locks for **timber doors, steel doors, aluminium doors, gates**, plus specialist lines like **fire-tested keypads** and **marine-grade/weather-resistant** options for exposed installations.

A big “Borg-ism” you’ll see repeatedly is **easy code management** - for example their **Easicode Pro (ECP)** range is designed for **on-the-door code changes** without removing the lock (useful for rentals, staff turnover, site access, etc.).
