D&D Technologies



D&D Technologies is an **Australian gate-hardware specialist** best known for inventing the **MagnaLatch®**—a magnetic, child-safety gate latch that became a global go-to for **pool and perimeter gate safety**. The company was **established in the late 1980s** and built its reputation on solving the annoying real-world problems of gates: rust, sag, binding, and “why is this latch suddenly possessed?”

What they make

D&D’s range is essentially “everything that makes a gate behave”:

- **MagnaLatch®** magnetic safety latches (including the **MagnaLatch ALERT** variants that combine a latch + alarm concept in one unit)
- **TruClose®** self-closing hinges, built with **engineering polymers + stainless components** to avoid corrosion, staining, and sagging, and designed to be adjustable and installer-friendly
- **LokkLatch®** gate latches/locks and other privacy/security gate hardware aimed at residential and light commercial perimeter security

They’re strongly associated with **pool safety compliance** and family safety messaging, but they also explicitly sell **heavy-duty gate hardware** for **commercial, industrial, and automated gates**.

Where they’re based / footprint

D&D lists operations in **Frenchs Forest, NSW (Australia)** and a US presence via **D&D Technologies (USA) Inc.** in **Huntington Beach, California**. Notably, their contact emails use the **assaabloy.com** domain, reflecting their current group ownership.

Ownership

As of **2 May 2024**, **ASSA ABLOY** announced it had acquired D&D Technologies, adding it to the ASSA ABLOY Opening Solutions brand portfolio.
