The dormakaba 900 Series 919-3 (formerly known as the Kaba Simplex) is a robust, fully mechanical digital lock designed to provide secure, keyless access control without the need for batteries or wiring. This weather-resistant lock is ideal for both light commercial and residential doors, offering a reliable security solution for low to medium-traffic areas.

The 919-3 model is specifically designed to suit doors with a thickness of 44mm to 54mm. It comes supplied with a medium-duty rim deadlatch and a convenient internal lever handle, ensuring a quick and easy free exit from the inside. On the outside, entry is gained via a thumbturn after entering the correct code.

With a user-friendly 5-button keypad, you can set a single access code of 1 to 5 digits, choosing from over 1,000 possible combinations. Code changes are fast and straightforward, and can be completed while the unit is still fitted to the door. For added security, the lock features a protective clutch mechanism to prevent damage from forced entry attempts, and a handy latch holdback function to allow free passage when required.

dormakaba is a Swiss-headquartered global access-solutions company that builds the stuff that makes buildings actually *work*: **door hardware**, **door closers**, **automatic entrances**, **electronic access control**, and **keying/locking systems** across commercial, residential, and institutional sites. The group is based in **Rümlang (Zurich), Switzerland** and sells into **50+ countries** with a large installed base in doors, hotels, airports, offices, and public buildings.

The modern company was created through the **merger of Germany's dorma and Switzerland's Kaba**, finalized in **September 2015** (initially branded "dorma+kaba," later standardized as **dormakaba**). That merger fused two long-running lineages: **DORMA (founded 1908 in Ennepetal, Germany)** with deep door-technology roots, and **Kaba** with a long history in locking/identification (origins going back to the 19th century in Zurich).

What dormakaba is known for in the trade/spec world is the "whole doorway" approach:

- **Door hardware + control** (closers, floor springs, related hardware)
- **Entrance systems** (automatic doors, turnstiles/personnel gates depending on market)
- **Access control & identity** (credentials, electronic locking, and management layers)

Scale-wise, dormakaba reported **net sales of CHF 2.87bn** for **FY 2024/25** and **~15k employees** (15,346 cited), reflecting a genuinely large global footprint.
