Brand Profile

dormakaba



dormakaba is a Swiss-headquartered global access-solutions company that builds the stuff that makes buildings actually *work*: **door hardware, door closers, automatic entrances, electronic access control, and keying/locking systems** across commercial, residential, and institutional sites. The group is based in **Rümlang (Zurich), Switzerland** and sells into **50+ countries** with a large installed base in doors, hotels, airports, offices, and public buildings.

The modern company was created through the **merger of Germany's dorma and Switzerland's Kaba**, finalized in **September 2015** (initially branded "dorma+kaba," later standardized as **dormakaba**). That merger fused two long-running lineages: **DORMA (founded 1908 in Ennepetal, Germany)** with deep door-technology roots, and **Kaba** with a long history in locking/identification (origins going back to the 19th century in Zurich).

What dormakaba is known for in the trade/spec world is the "whole doorway" approach:

- **Door hardware + control** (closers, floor springs, related hardware)
- **Entrance systems** (automatic doors, turnstiles/personnel gates depending on market)
- **Access control & identity** (credentials, electronic locking, and management layers)

Scale-wise, dormakaba reported **net sales of CHF 2.87bn** for **FY 2024/25** and **~15k employees** (15,346 cited), reflecting a genuinely large global footprint.
