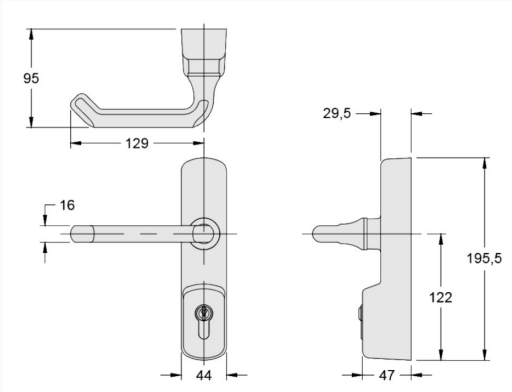

Product Description

The Exidor 525 Euro Lever Operated Outside Access Device (OAD) is a high-quality external entry solution designed specifically for use with the Exidor 500 series range of panic bolts and emergency latches. Suitable for timber, metal, and UPVC doors, this unit allows authorised access from the outside of the door while ensuring the internal emergency exit hardware remains fully operational.

This device is supplied complete with a 45mm half euro profile cylinder and three keys. For enhanced security and durability, the lever is designed to disengage from the mechanism when locked; it will still rotate freely, preventing forced entry and protecting the internal components from damage. Once unlocked, the lever engages to retract the internal bolts or latches.

The lever handle meets the dimensional requirements of BS 8300 and Approved Document 'M' (Equality Act), making it ideal for barrier-free access in high-traffic commercial and industrial environments. It features a fully reversible design for easy installation on both left and right-handed doors, and is finished in a durable Dull Metal Grey.

Exidor is a UK panic-and-emergency-exit hardware brand best known for **push bars, push pads, and multi-point exit devices** used on fire exits and escape routes in commercial buildings. It's one of those "you don't notice it until you *really* need it" brands—built around reliable, standards-compliant egress hardware.

Exidor says it has been a leading manufacturer in this category for **around 90 years**, and trade/brand info places its establishment at **1931**.

Standards & compliance are central to the brand's positioning: Exidor panic and emergency exit devices are marketed as **CE marked** and **tested to EN 1125 (panic exit devices)** and **EN 179 (emergency exit devices)**—the core European standards that specifiers and installers care about for public buildings and controlled escape routes.

Ownership / group: Exidor was acquired by **ASSA ABLOY Opening Solutions UK & Ireland in 2018** (widely reported in trade press), and Companies House filings list **Assa Abloy Limited** as the controlling party.

Where it sits today: Exidor is now presented as a **range within the UNION family** (ASSA ABLOY's UK door hardware portfolio), and the brand is used across "real world" commercial projects where you might need bespoke finishes, different keep/bolt options, alarms, or microswitch variants for monitoring.
