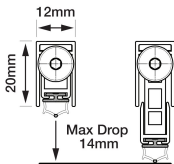

Product Description

The FIRESTOP Trend Drop Down Seal is a highly effective, rebated door seal designed to provide a discreet barrier against fire, smoke, noise, light, and insects. Recessed into the bottom of timber doors, this seal remains hidden until activated by the closing action of the door, ensuring a seamless and clean aesthetic.

This durable seal features an aluminium body with a self-directing reinforced plunger and a high-quality, self-extinguishing co-extruded seal. It has been endurance-tested to 200,000 cycles and offers a maximum drop of 14mm. For a precise fit, the seal can be trimmed down by up to 200mm.

It is fully tested to meet rigorous safety standards, achieving up to 60 minutes of fire resistance (BS EN 1634-1 & BS476: Part 22), smoke protection (BS EN 1634-3: 2004), and acoustic reduction of up to 39dB Rw (BS EN ISO 10140-1 & BS EN ISO 10140-2).

Firestop is a UK manufacturer specialising in **passive fire protection** products for doors and hardware, best known for **intumescent seals** and **intumescent “hardware protection” kits** that help fire doors keep their integrity when exposed to heat and smoke. They position the brand around “protecting life and property,” with **25+ years** of experience supplying the UK and overseas markets.

What Firestop actually makes (the stuff you’ll see in the trade channel):

- **Intumescent fire & smoke seals** (the strips that expand in a fire to close the gap between door and frame).
- **Intumescent ironmongery protection:** sheets/pads/liners used behind or around items like **hinges, locks, latches and closers** to maintain the fire-rating of the door set.
- **Fire-rated ironmongery** items such as **intumescent letter plates** and **door viewers**, designed so adding openings to a fire door doesn’t ruin the door’s performance.
- Often also stocked as **drop-down door seals** and related door-bottom sealing hardware for fire/smoke control and acoustic performance.

A detail they stress is **traceability**: Firestop highlights a **traceable production code / certification** approach so installers/specifiers can link products back to compliance evidence and batch provenance.
