The ICS EB300VGL is a high-quality, surface-mounted electric solenoid drop bolt designed specifically for frameless glass door applications. Operating on 12V DC, this solenoid bolt features a fail-safe (power to lock / fail unlocked) operation, ensuring the door unlocks automatically during a power failure to allow safe emergency egress. It offers a strong holding force of 544kg (1200lbs) and is fully monitored, providing reliable feedback on the door's position status. To prevent premature locking, it includes an adjustable auto-relocking timer delay that can be set to 0, 3, 6, or 9 seconds. Built for longevity, the EB300VGL has been rigorously tested to 500,000 cycles and is housed in a sleek anodised aluminium finish.

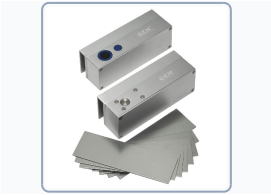

ICS Security (ICS Security Solutions Ltd) is a UK access-control hardware brand and supplier focused on the “nuts and bolts” of electronic door control: **maglocks, electric locks/bolts, strikes, lock releases, and packaged locking kits** designed to make access-control installs cleaner and more reliable. They describe themselves as an access-control specialist founded in **2003**, with **20+ years** in the sector.

They operate from **Blisworth, Northamptonshire** (Units 1–2, JBJ Business Park, Northampton Road, NN7 3DW), supporting trade customers with a range that covers the common building blocks of access control systems.

Product-wise, ICS’s catalogue is very “installer reality”:

- **Magnetic locks** in multiple formats (standard, slimline/transom, stainless, monitored, with door status options), typically running **12–24V DC selectable** and specced by holding force (e.g., 600–1200 lbs and up).
- **Electric locks / bolts and locking kits**, including “compliant lock packages” that bundle the parts needed for controlled entry with free egress, calling out standards like **EN179 / EN1125** in their kit descriptions.
- A broader access-control “system parts” approach: they position the range as covering “all parts of access control systems,” aiming to let installers choose a complete solution from one source.
