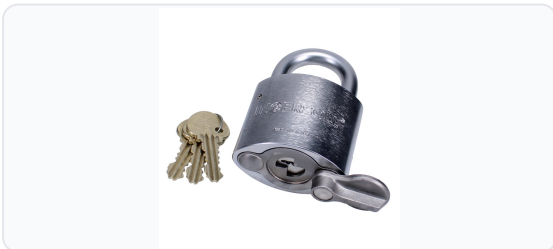

The Ingersoll 700 Series OS711 (1711) is a high-security open shackle padlock designed to provide robust protection for demanding security applications. Featuring a heavy-duty body constructed from hardened steel laminations with a satin chrome finish, this padlock offers exceptional resistance to physical attacks and harsh weather conditions.

At the heart of its security is the legendary Ingersoll 10-lever cylinder mechanism, providing superior resistance against picking and manipulation. To defend against forced entry, all vital parts of the key mechanism are protected by anti-drill barriers, while a double ball locking mechanism securely grips the 10mm hardened steel shackle at both ends. For added security, the padlock is key-retaining, meaning the key can only be withdrawn when the padlock is fully locked, ensuring it is never accidentally left open.

Supplied with three keys as standard, this padlock is ideal for securing gates, warehouses, industrial units, and high-value equipment.

Brand Profile

Ingersoll



Ingersoll is a historic **British high-security lock brand**, best known for its distinctive **rim nightlatches** and the long-running **SC71**—a “signature” product whose chunky look and unique key profile are basically part of the brand’s identity. Ingersoll Locks Limited states it was **founded in 1949** and has focused on security-led lock design ever since.

A key part of the origin story centers on inventor **Jack W. Taylor**, who (according to a detailed brand history) conceived the idea for a **ten-lever cylinder** in **1944**, and the Ingersoll range grew from that high-security cylinder concept.

In today’s market, “Ingersoll” is still used as shorthand for **serious, mechanical, front-door security**—the kind of lock people pick when they want something robust, familiar to locksmiths, and not dependent on batteries, apps, or vibes.

Ownership-wise, the **Ingersoll trademark/maker is described as being owned by the ASSA ABLOY Group** (noting this is stated by a specialist distributor/reseller who explicitly separates themselves from the trademark owner).
