



The Lowe & Fletcher 1346 Rollerarm Multi-Drawer Lock is a highly reliable and efficient locking solution specifically designed for metal filing cabinets and office desk pedestals.

Engineered for quick and straightforward installation, this lock features a snap-fixing design that allows it to be fitted in seconds. It operates in conjunction with a standard locking bar (not supplied) fitted with pegs. Turning the key 180 degrees clockwise rotates the roller cam on the back of the lock, moving the locking bar downward so the pegs engage with the drawer catch plates to secure multiple drawers at once. In the open position, the roller cam moves past top dead centre, preventing the locking bar from dropping and accidentally locking the cabinet.

This model features a square head shape, a high-quality nickel-plated finish, and is supplied keyed to differ on the 92 key series with 200 differs. It comes complete with two keys.

## Brand Profile

Lowe & Fletcher



**Lowe & Fletcher** is a long-established British manufacturer of **locking systems for industry**, best known for high-volume, application-specific locks like **camlocks, quarter-turns, compression locks, and electronic/keypad solutions** used on things like **enclosures, cabinets, lockers, post/parcel units, and industrial equipment**. They're a **sixth-generation, family-owned** business with roots going back to **1889**, when **John Lowe and Thomas Fletcher** founded a lockmaking firm in **Willenhall** in the Black Country—one of the historic heartlands of UK lockmaking.

Today, Lowe & Fletcher forms part of the **Lowe & Fletcher Group**, which describes two main divisions: **Locking Systems** (industrial/OEM locks) and **Fire Safety** (smoke and fire containment systems).

Operationally, their Locking Systems division includes UK operations based around the West Midlands (e.g., **Wednesbury, WS10 7DE**) and they state they have multiple operational sites across Europe and the US to serve local and specialist markets.

On the product side, their camlock range alone spans **mini camlocks, standard camlocks, slamlocks, and IP-rated water-resistant variants** (with application-driven options like tool/coin operation and different cam geometries).
