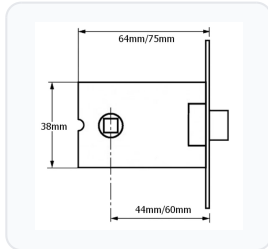
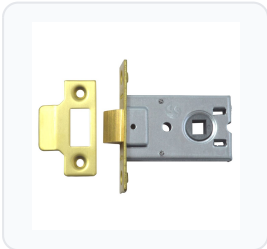

Legge is a heritage **British lock and latch brand** with roots in **Willenhall** (the UK's traditional lockmaking hub). Allegion UK traces the brand's history back to **1881**, and Legge is still best known for dependable "everyday" **mortice locks, sashlocks, latches, nightlatches, and bathroom locks**—the kind of core door hardware that shows up everywhere from period homes to general commercial fit-outs.

Today, **Legge is part of Allegion**, sitting alongside other door-hardware brands in the group's portfolio. Allegion positions Legge as a premium, durable hardware line for **commercial and institutional** use, while in the UK it's particularly associated with **residential-style lockcases and latches** sold through trade and ironmongery channels.

On the compliance side, Legge ranges include **British Standard** options such as **BS 3621** 5-lever mortice deadlocks (often used for insurance-friendly front door security), with product pages calling out attack resistance features and UKCA/ratings where applicable.
