The Squire SS50CP5 Stronghold is a high-security, closed-shackle padlock designed to deliver exceptional protection in the most demanding environments. Combining a compact 50mm solid hardened steel body with a 10mm hardened boron alloy steel shackle, this padlock offers formidable resistance against sawing, cutting, drilling, and picking. The closed shackle design significantly reduces shackle exposure, making it extremely difficult for attackers to apply bolt croppers or other tools.

Engineered for reliable performance in harsh weather conditions, it features an electrophoretic finish that provides outstanding corrosion resistance, having been salt spray tested for over 200 hours. It is highly suited for securing garages, warehouses, perimeter gates, trailers, and high-security doors. The padlock features a 5-pin cylinder mechanism with 1,500 key differs, is fully rekeyable, and has a key-retaining design to ensure the key can only be withdrawn when the lock is safely secured.

Brand Profile

Squire



Squire (formally **Henry Squire & Sons Ltd**) is one of the UK's oldest lockmakers — a heritage brand best known for **serious padlocks and chain security**, especially in the motorcycle, commercial, and site-security world. Squire's own history traces the business back to **1780**, when **William Squire** began making locks in **Willenhall** (the Black Country's lockmaking capital). They even supplied locks to the **British Army during the Napoleonic Wars**, which is a wildly specific flex that basically translates to: "we've been thinking about forced entry since muskets were a performance upgrade."

Operationally, the trading entity behind the brand is **Henry Squire & Sons Limited**.

What Squire is known for

Squire's modern identity is anchored in **high-security padlocks** and matching **hardened chains / accessories**, with the flagship line being **Stronghold®**. Their own "About" page calls out products like the **Stronghold SS100cs** as an ultra-high-security production padlock (Squire describe it as the world's strongest production padlock — not subtle, but neither is a 1kg lump of hardened steel).

A good example of how the brand positions itself in real-world standards:

- The **Squire SS65CS Stronghold** is independently listed by **Sold Secure** with **CEN Grade 6** and a **Powered Cycle Gold** rating, alongside features like hardened components and weather resistance.
